

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE 1997

The 25th Llanfair & District Agriculture & Horticulture Show

The First Llanfair & District Show was held in 1891 on the field behind the Vicarage, now occupied by Hafendeg. It later moved to Dol y Foxes, now the Smithfield, and then on to Mount Field after its aquisition in 1922, and continued there until 1939 and was then discontinued due to the War.

A Horticultural, Arts & Crafts show was revived by the Recreation Association in 1962 and continued as an annual event at the Public Institute until 1972, with a farm produce section added in latter years.

Robert Jones called a public meeting on 30th April 1973, to seek support for reviving the show and there was unanimous support. £91 plus interest remain in the Old Show Account and a letter seeking membership was circulated with £461 being realised. (£2195 in 1996!) Things then moved swiftly, with the show being held on Mount Field on Saturday 8th September 1973.

Local businesses supported with adverts on every page of the Schedule and two trade stands, Derwas of Welshpool and Cefn Coch Woodwork Centre. The Show was an outstanding success and the day finished with a Show Dance at the Institute. The Shows success and its likely growth was discussed at length at the AGM resulting in a move to the Pentre Field, 1974 to 1994. Buses to be arranged and Bronygarth field given free for parking. Growth has been steady but kept under tight control by a hard working committee, experts at begging and borrowing piles, ropes, netting etc. until the Show could aquire its own.

The weather has been kind except for a storm in 1984 when the Officials and members were busy from 4am, on the phone etc. salvaging the event. The committee and competitors were marvellous in their response to ensure the show went on.

There have only been a few problems, such as cattle breaking out of their pens to the river and roadway. The show was used as a setting for the S4C filming of Yn ol i Leifior. A Sheep Dog Trials section was added in 1986 and sheep shearing competition in 1987.

In 1995 the show moved to the Mathrafal Field, a beautiful and bigger setting in the Meifod Valley where we celebrate our 25th Show since its revival. Throughout this period - a quarter of a Century - the team spirit of the committee and other helpers has been excellent, resulting in one of the best one day shows in the area.

Ail gychwynwyd Siou Garddwriaeth, Celf a chreft gan y Gymdeithas Adloniant ym 1973 gyda'r bwriad o ail gychwyn y Siou, lle bu cefnogaeth unfrydol. Roedd £91 yng nghyfrif yr hen siou a chyda cyclhlyth yr yn ahnog aelodaetg codwyd £461 (£2195 in 1996). Aethpwyd ym laen yn gyflym gyda siou a'r gae'r Mownt ar y Sadwrn 8ed Med 1973.

Cafwyd gefnogaeth bussnesau lleol gyda hysbysebion a'r bob tudalen y rhaglen a dwy stoudin fusnes, Derwas o'r Trallwng a chaudfan Gwaith Coed Cefn Coch. Bu siou ardderchog yn diweddu a pheldioed 5 bob ochr, Dawnsio Gwern a dathliodau eraill yn achhosi am i allwodd car yn coel en gadael gydar heddlu! gorffebwyd y dydd gyda Dawns y Siou yn yr Institwt.

Ar ol trafod y llwyddiant a'r tydiant i dodd yn y Cyfarfod Blynyddol penderfynwyd symud i gae'r Pentre, 1974 i 1994. Trefnwyd bwsiau cludo i'r cae a chafwyd caer Bronygarth yn ddigost fel cae parcio. Bu tyfriant graddol o dan wyliadwriaeth manwl pwyllgor brwdfrydig a medrus ar fenthyea pyst, net etc. hyd y gallai'r siou gael rai eu hunain.

RULES AND REGULATIONS RHEOLAU AC AMODAU

- 1 That the Society shall be called the "Llanfair Caereinion and District Agricultural and Horticultural Society" and Local Classes shall comprise the following district All residences within the Llanfair Caereinion High School Catchment area. Open Classes as shown in the Schedule are open to Competitors from any distance.
- 2 That every subscriber of £3.00 and upwards annually, £1.00 (16 years and under) shall be a Member of the Society, and that subscriptions shall be considered due on the 1st April of each year.
- 3 All stock exhibited (except ring events) must have been in the possession of the Exhibitor at least Two Months previous to the day of the Show. All Exhibits in the Agricultural Produce Class must be the Bona Fide property of the Exhibitor, grown, produced or manufactured on their particular holding.
- 4 The Exhibitor ONLY will be issued with a free pass ticket, subject to Entry Fees exceeding £3.00.
- 5 Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from any animal exhibited by him, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Society against all legal proceedings in regard thereto, and repair any injury which may be so occasioned.
- 6 Should the right of any party to a prize be disputed, notice of the same must be given to the Secretary, in writing, on the day of the Show before 6.00pm. This refers to all Classes.
- 7 Any person lodging a protest must deposit, at the same time the sum of £5.00 which shall be forfeited to the Society (at the discretion of the Committee) if the protest be not sustained.
- 8 All parties exhibiting at this Society's Show must governed by the Rules and Regulations as interpreted by the Secretary.
- 9 All stock must be on the Show Ground by 9.30 promptly unless otherwise stated in Schedule. Judging will commence at 10.00am except in the Ring Events which will commence as stated.
- 10 Payment of Prizes will be made on production of Prize Cards to the Treasurer. Prize money will be claimed on the day of the Show.
- 11 The Silver Cups are perpetual unless otherwise stated and must be returned to the Society's Bank (Midland Bank, Llanfair Caereinion) by the 1st day of August following that in which the cup was won.
- 12 Entries close on Saturday, 23rd August. Entries must be accompanied by the Entry Fee and should be posted to the relevant Section Secretary (details in appropriate Schedule Section) or handed in at The Institute, Llanfair, on Saturday, 23rd August, between 10.00am and 12 noon.
- 13 Donators of Cups and Prizes shall become Members of the Society for the year in which the Cup was donated. Donators of Cups and Trophies are respectfully asked to have them engraved before handing over to the Society, in time for Show Day.
- 14 Perpetual Cups will remain the property of the Society, unless otherwise stated. If a Cup is won three times in succession or on five separate occasions by the same exhibitor, the Society will give a suitable Replica. This Rule commenced in 1977.
