

RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SOCIETY/ RHEOLAU AC AMODAU O'R GYMDEITHAS

That the Society shall be called "Llanfair Caereinion and District Agricultural and Horticultural Society". Local Classes competitions shall be for persons residing within the Llanfair Caereinion High School catchment area with the Open Classes as shown in the schedule are open to competitors from any distance.

That every subscriber of £7.00 and upwards annually, £3.00 (15 years and under) shall be a Member of the Society, and that subscriptions shall be considered due on the 1st April of each year.

All stock exhibited (except ring events) must have been in the possession of the Exhibitor for at least 2 months prior to Show Day. All exhibits in the Agricultural Produce Class must be the Bona Fide property of the Exhibitor, grown, produced or manufactured on their particular holding.

The Exhibitor ONLY will be issued with a free pass ticket, subject to Entry Fees exceeding £3.00 Exhibitors shall be responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage including liability occasioned by or arising from any animal including dogs and horses, poultry or item entered for competition or display.

Should the right of any part to a prize be disputed, notice of the same must be given to the Secretary, in writing, on the day of the Show before 6.00pm. This refers to all classes.

Any person lodging a protest must deposit, at the same time the sum of £5.00, which shall be forfeited to the Society (at the discretion of the Committee) if the protest is not sustained.

All parties exhibiting at this Society's Show must be governed by the Rules and Regulation as interpreted by the Secretary.

All stock must be on the Show Ground by 9.30am promptly unless otherwise stated in the Schedule. Judging will commence at 10.00am except the Ring Events which will commence as stated. Payment of prizes will be made on production of Prize Cards to the Treasurer. Prize money must be claimed on day of the Show.

The Silver Cups are perpetual unless otherwise stated and must be returned to the Show Secretaries or Section Secretary by the 1st of August following that in which the cup was won.

Entries close on Saturday, 29th August. Entries must be accompanied by the Entry Fee and should be posted to the relevant Section Secretary or handed in at The Institute, Llanfair Caereinion on Saturday, 29th August between 10.00am and 12 noon.

Donors of Cups and Prizes shall become Members of the Society for the year in which the Cup was donated. Donors of Cups and Trophies are respectfully asked to have them engraved before handing over to the Society, in time for Show Day.

Perpetual Cups will remain the property of the Society, unless otherwise stated.



Grease and line a 7inch round cake tin with greased greaseproof paper. Clean fruit. Sift together flour and baking powder. Cream fat, sugar and honey until pale and creamy. Add eggs one at a time, beating well after each one. Lightly fold in the flour, milk, fruit and lemon rind. Turn the mixture into the tin and arrange a ring of almonds around the edge. Bake in a moderate oven 350°F/Gas 4 for half an hour, then at 325°F/Gas 3 for a further 1 to 1½ hours, covering the top of the cake with greaseproof paper if necessary, to prevent it going too brown. Cool in in for 10 mins before turning out on a wire tray.

RASPBERRY & WHITE CHOCOLATE BLONDIE - CLASS 3

115g margarine115g caster sugar2 medium eggs125g plain flour200g white chocolate115g raspberries

Melt margarine and half the chocolate and stir until smooth. Whisk eggs and sugar until thick and creamy. Add sieved flour and chocolate mixture and fold in gently. chop remaining chocolate & add half along with half the raspberries to the mixture. Pour mixture into 18cm (7in) square tin or similar. Sprinkle remaining chocolate and raspberries on top. Bake at 190°C/Gas 5 for 35-45 mins until golden. Leave to cool before cutting into squares.

PINEAPPLE FRUIT CAKE - CLASS 10

4oz glace cherries

220g tin of pineapple in juice

4oz butter

12oz mixed fruit

6oz soft brown sugar 8oz S R Flour

2 eggs

Pre-heat oven to $170^{\circ}\text{C}/350^{\circ}\text{F/Gas}$ mark 3. Chop the cherries and pineaple (keep the juice). Put in saucepan with pineapple juice, butter, mixed fruit and brown sugar. Heat to melt the butter but do not boil. Leave to cool then beat in the eggs. Finally stir in the flour. Turn into a prepared 8inch round tin (approx) and bake for 1 to $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours.

(CHERRY AND COCONUT CAKE - CLASS 12)

150g/5oz S R Flour 5 tablespoons milk

1/4 tsp salt 175g/6oz glace cherries, washed and halved

125g/4oz caster sugar 50g/2oz desiccated coconut 75g/3oz butter 1 tablespoon demerara sugar

1egg

Sift the flour and salt into a bowl, stir in the caster sugar, then rub in the butter until the mixture resembles breadcrumbs. Beat the egg and milk together. Mix the cherries and the coconut together. Add both to the flour mixture and fold in gently. Turn the mixture into a greased and floured 500g/1lb loaf tin and sprinkle with demerara sugar. Bake in a preheated moderate oven, 180°C/350°F/Gas mark 4 for 45 - 50 mins or until firm to touch. Transfer to a wire rack to cool.

MINI ROCKY ROAD CAKES - CLASS 34

1 mug mini marshmallows 1 mug sultanas

1½ mugs chocolate buttons 35g butter

1 mug broken digestive biscuits

Put the chocolate buttons and butter in the microwaveable dish and heat for 35seconds (or until melted). Remove from the microwave and mix well. Place the sultanas, biscuits and mini marshmallows in a bowl with the melted chocolate and butter and mix well so that everything is coated. All thats left to do is to place the mixture in small 'blobs' onto a foil covered baking tray ready to put into the fridge for about 20mins or until set.

Suggestion: you can add cherries or change ingredients to suit your own taste.

- The Judges shall have power to withhold Prizes in cases where specimens are not of sufficient merit.
- 5. The Judges' decision to be final.



If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Regulations
